gin that today children are going to investigate the story of a famous character called adica, who lived in Britain around the time of the Roman Invasion. Tell pupils that good orians act like detectives, by looking for clues about the past in 'sources' of information. roes can include objects, writing or pictures.

sources can include augects, Writing pictories. Hand out copies of Resource S and ask pupils to discuss what information about Boudica might be discoverable from each of these real historical sources. You may ask pupils to read the sources independently or you can read them together as a class. Can pupils start to piece together ideas about who Boudica was from the sources? Ask pupils to choose se points about Boudica from the sources. Draw attention to the date of each source and ask publis to think about which ones were written negrest to the time of the Romo mpire. Discuss whether or not this makes them more useful as historical sources. NB: the ources contain different variant spellings of Boudica's name.
